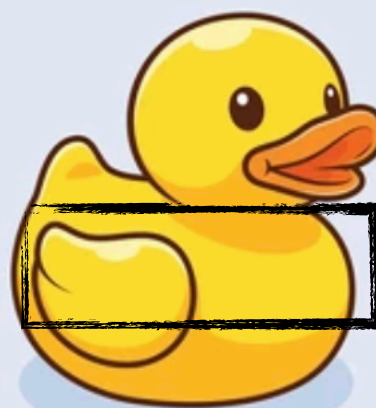

Hopefully you have heard from your children all about Ready, Safe and Kind. We have reviewed our Behaviour and Relationships Policy and brought it in line with the Restorative Practice that we have been using in school for about a year now.

Restorative Practice is all about having discussions with the children about their choices, working with other children to see how they are feeling and working together to find a solution to the situation. The children and adults are working hard to work through anything that happens and this sometimes takes a little time.

I have attached the parent guide to this email and if you would like to read the full Behaviour and Relationships Policy you can find it on the school website.

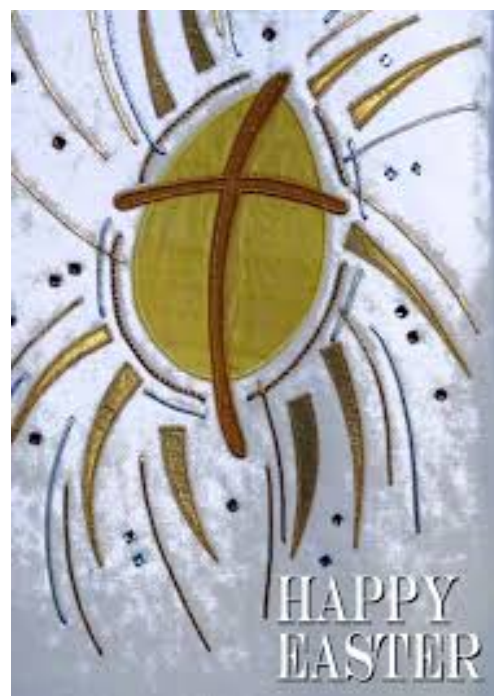
A message from Newbold:
