INTENT

At Newbold and Tredington C of E Primary school our **Art Curriculum Intent** aims for children to become self-motivated artists and to be creative and represent their developing sense of self across different mediums in a practical and inspiring way.

Our school aims to develop children's social, emotional and mental well-being through a myriad of creative experiences. We encourage children to experiment and make mistakes; build resilience, invent new ways of thinking and boost confidence.

IMPLEMENTATION

Our Art Curriculum rolls over two years in a cycle and covers topics which provide children the opportunities to practise and develop their artistic techniques across many mediums whilst exploring different cultures through art. Children also study focus artists across the two years, giving a broad perspective of how artists are inspired to work using their surroundings and experience to shape their work.

Children have the opportunities to develop their skills within the following art forms, across different scales, independently and collaboratively:

- Painting and collage
- Print making and collage
- 3D sculpture
- Digital media and animation
