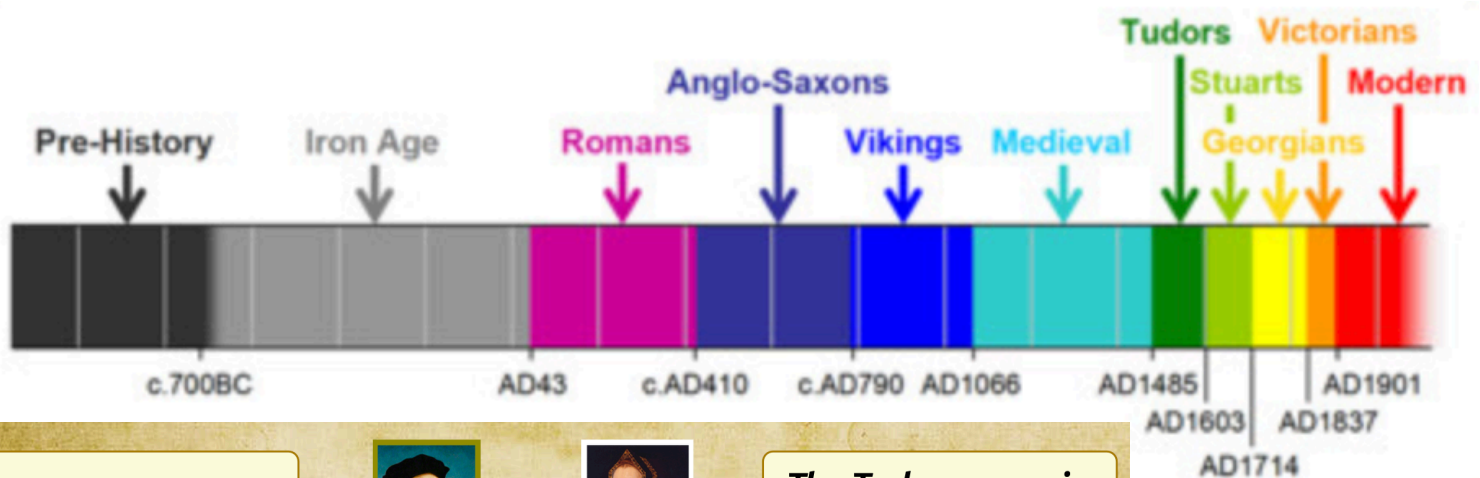

## Sticky knowledge about Elizabeth I

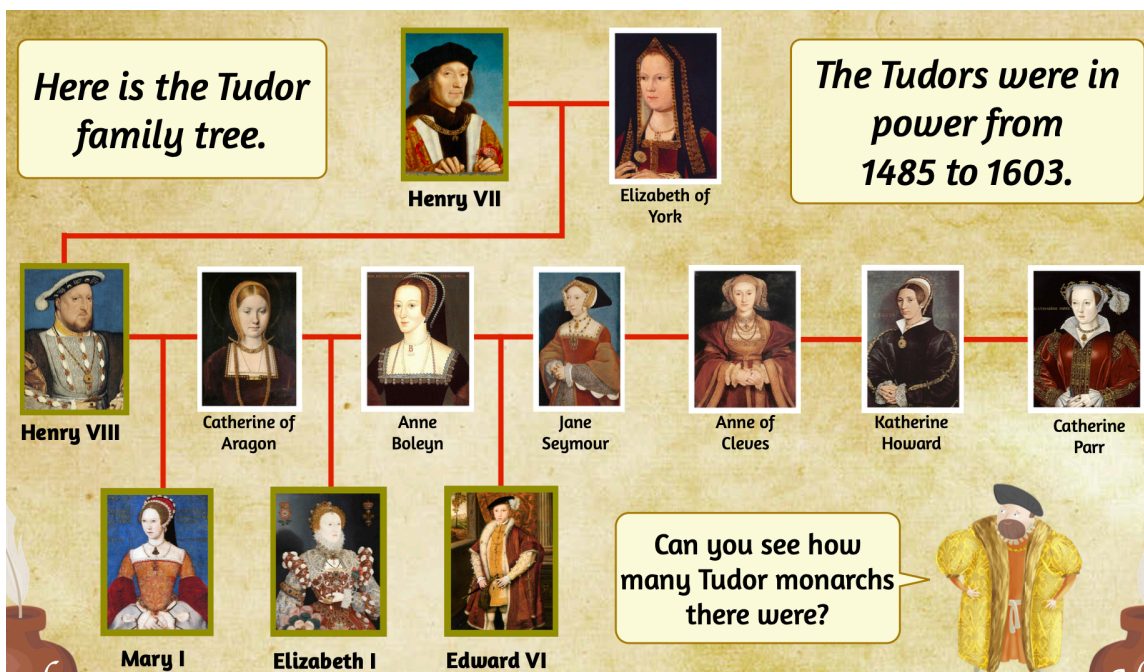
- The Tudor period is the period between 1485 and 1603. This was when the Tudors were the ruling family in England.
- Elizabeth I was the daughter of King Henry VIII and his wife Anne Boleyn
- Much of Europe was split into Protestant and Catholic nations: Spain was Catholic and England was Protestant
- Explorers travelled the world to share their religion to new countries and trade goods for exotic foods such as spices

Here is where the Tudor period fits into British history - the Elizabethan era comes **at the end of the Tudors** and **before the Stuarts' reign**.
