Alexander Graham Bell

Alexander Graham Bell was a Scottish scientist and inventor. His most famous invention was the first telephone.



Alexander's first telephone that worked (1875). However, the sound wasn't clear enough.



A copy of the first successful telephone, as was used on March 10th, 1876.

The Invention of the World Wide Web

In 1989, Sir Tim published his project plan, 'Information Management: A Proposal' which required the use of the Internet to share and access information globally. This was known as the World Wide Web. Sir Tim set out to ensure that the World Wide Web was available for free to all people around the world.
