Promoting Independence of our children

I am very aware that as our children head toward secondary school there is a need for them to become increasingly independent. In preparation for the transition to secondary school and to promote independence across the whole age range at Tredington, we have decided to make a few alterations to morning arrival at school. In a morning the children will be asked to put their book bags and belongings in class boxes that will be outside the blue railings by the door. The door into school will not be open as we want to encourage the children (and parents) to stay outside before school begins. We would also like parents to leave the playground before the bell goes so that we can get the children in quickly and they can sort out their own book bags. Parents who want to see a teacher at the start of day will still be able to and if you ask a member of staff on duty they will happily fetch them for you.

Children in Year 5 and 6 may walk to and from school provided that we have written consent from a parent/carer allowing them to do so.

If you wish to see Mrs Baker in the morning please can you go to the front door and not through the school.

I appreciate your co-operation with these matters and we will always be available to discuss pressing matters.

Dinner Money

At the start of the summer term the cost of school dinners will increase to £2.10 a day. Please can you continue to pay for the whole week on a Monday, as it means that we can inform the kitchens at Brailes in advance of our projected numbers.

Paying by BACS

Next term parents will be able to pay for school trips, dinner monies, swimming etc by using BACS. BACS is the electronic transfer of money from bank account to bank account. If you wish to use this service to pay for activities at school it is vitally important that you reference your payment carefully. Please can you ensure that you include your child's name, date and the activity you are paying for on the reference. If you don't include all these details then it will be very difficult for the office to process the payments.
