#### **OUR GOVERNORS**

The Governors thought it would be useful to provide information to parents about what we do, so we're going to give an update in the school newsletter on a termly basis.

Within this first update, we thought it would be useful to give an overview of what the role of the Governing Body is and who we are.

Governors have a number of responsibilities, which are primarily:

- Setting the school's vision, ethos and strategic direction
- Agreeing its policies and objectives
- Holding the Head teacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils
- Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure that the school budget is spent responsibly
- Appointing the Head teacher and monitoring their performance

Decisions taken by Governors are based on the advice of committees, made up of members of the Governing Body, which deal with specific issues and report back to the Governing Body. The two sub committees are the Performance and Standards and the Resources committee.

Both of these committees meet once per term and discuss relevant issues, all within the context of ensuring that the children at school are equipped with the tools, teaching and learning to enable them to develop and make progress.

Some Governors also have specific responsibilities for other areas, such as Maths, Literacy, Science, School Finances, and Health and Safety - these Governors also meet with appropriate members of staff on at least a termly basis and report back to the Governing Body.

Governors are elected for a an initial four year term and are given the opportunity to undergo training to ensure that they can keep up to date with relevant legislation and improve their skills.

The Governing Body of the school is currently made up of ten governors, including two members of staff and three parent governors, as follows:

## Promoting Independence of our children

Thank you for your cooperation with the changes to the morning arrangements at Tredington. The teachers have already commented on the fact that their mornings are more productive and the children are aware of what they have brought in. We have also addressed a safeguarding issue related to unaccompanied adults moving around the school.

We are aware that the openness of the school is very important at Newbold and Tredington and we would like to introduce the next part of our revised morning plan. The doors will be open to parents on Friday morning, so that you have the opportunity to come into the classroom and look at the displays and work. I do ask that if you need to go to the office, you go around the outside and not through the main building.

At the start of the autumn term there will be a period of time when the classrooms will be open to settle the children into their new classes. I would encourage the older children to continue to be independent and sort out themselves in a morning.

## Reminder for Parents - Leave Of Absence during Term Time

As you will all be aware, current attendance regulations stipulate a Head teacher may not grant a leave of absence during term-time unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Each application for a leave of absence will be considered on a case by case basis and on its own merits.

It is for the Head Teacher to decide what he/she views as 'exceptional' and it is at their discretion if the circumstances warrant the leave to be granted. If the leave is granted, the head teacher is able to determine the number of school days a child can be absent for. The school can only consider Leave of Absence requests which are made by the 'resident' parent. Where applications for leave of absence are made in advance and refused, the child will be required to be in school on the dates set out in the application. If the child is absent during that period, it will be recorded as an unauthorised absence, which may result in legal action being taken against the parent(s), by way of a Fixed Penalty Notice.

Failure to make an application for leave in advance can also result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued to the parent(s).

Where a Fixed Penalty Notice is issued and not paid within the required timeframe as set out on the notice, the matter will be referred to Warwickshire County Council's Legal Services to consider instigating criminal proceedings under S444 Education Act 1996.

Parents are asked to respect the new regulations under which the school must work and if there is a need to take a child out of school during term-time, an application or request must be made in advance and make clear how the circumstances are exceptional.
