Attendance in term time

Pupils' welfare is of paramount importance to us and we believe that regular attendance throughout the year is essential for their success and fulfilment.

To give you an example of how your child's attendance can be affected please see the facts below.

- 20 days off per school year = 90% attendance
- 90% attendance = 4 whole weeks off school
- 90% attendance for your child throughout Primary and Secondary School means they will have missed a whole year of school in their education.

It is my responsibility as Head Teacher to monitor attendance across the school and notify parents if your child is falling below the school's target of 96%
