Please remember that on Tuesday 7th July the children will have the opportunity to meet their new class teachers.

### Attendance in term time

As I mentioned in the previous new letter, attendance at school is of paramount importance to us and can affect your child's learning.

As a head teacher I am not longer allowed to authorise absence in term time except for exceptional circumstances.

I would encourage you to apply for a Leave of Absence if you are intending to take holiday in term time because if I have reason to believe that a holiday has been taken, the children will be marked as an unauthorised absence.

As a school we promote trust and truthfulness and it puts the children in a difficult position when they are with their friends.

Please note that there is an amendment to the school's attendance policy that states:

4.6 If a child is absent for 4 or more days consecutively then parents will be asked to provide medical evidence.

A full copy of the policy is available on the school website and this amendment will be added for September 2015.

As part of our attendance policy I am also going to be sending out letters to parents, towards the end of term, if your child has had an attendance figure, for the summer term, of less than 95%. This letter is a reminder of the importance of attending school regularly. Please feel free to contact me if you wish to discuss the matter.
