We are delighted to share our recent good SIAMS report following an inspection by the National Society Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools.

SIAMS stands for the Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools. All Church of England dioceses and the Methodist Church use the National Society's framework as a process for evaluating the extent to which church schools are "distinctively and recognisably Christian institutions".

A SIAMS inspection focuses on the effect that the Christian ethos of the school has on the students who attend it.

The focus of the inspection is around four key questions:

- How well does the school, through its distinctive Christian character, meet the needs of all learners?
- What is the impact of collective worship on the academy community?
- · How effective is the Religious Education?
- · How effective are the leadership and management of the school as a church school?

We were really pleased with how the day went and the children were a credit to our school. Our inspector commented on how it was a pleasure to work with the children, who were so open and honest. I would also like to thank the parents and governors for they full support during their "interviews".

I think when you read the report, you will agree that Newbold and Tredington has a special quality that is a pleasure and honour to be part of.
