Tesco bags of help

Tredington Parish Council is delighted to announce it has secured a grant from the above scheme to improve the recreation ground in Tredington

There are three grants of different values: £8,000, £10,000 and £12,000. We do not know which amount we will be awarded, as the next stage of the process requires the public to vote. There are three schemes which will receive a grant in this area and the number of votes by Tesco customers will reflect which amount we receive.

Voting will take place from the 27th February to the 6th March in local Tesco stores. Customers will be given a token to vote for their preferred scheme. You can vote for our scheme in the following stores: Tesco Express Kinworton Road, Alcester; Studley Tesco Express; Tesco Express on Banbury Road, Stratford; and at the main Tesco Superstore at the Maybird Shopping Centre, Birmingham Road, Stratford.

The playground in Tredington is located off Blackwell Road, close to Newbold and Tredington Church of England School. The playground currently provides children's play equipment and areas for ball games, including basketball and football. Tredington Parish Council is currently raising money to up-grade the existing play equipment and provide more facilities suitable for a wider age-range.
