Lupus is an illness of the immune system. It can affect anybody and has symptoms that have a hugely detrimental impact on people's health including extreme fatigue; joint pain; kidney problems; heart and lung problems; rashes and depression. It can be triggered by underlying medical conditions and unfortunately there is currently no cure.

Lupus UK is the national charity that supports patients and carers, raises public and professional awareness of Lupus, and pays for specialist nurses in the NHS. Charitable

donations help them fund important research into finding more effective treatments for this condition, with the eventual goal of finding a cure.
