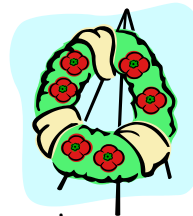

Floorball



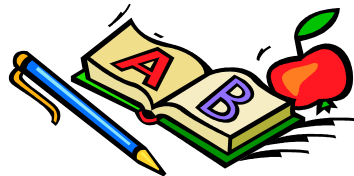
