Holiday Absence

In September 2013 the Government brought in new guidance tightening taking time off in term time. Head teachers are no longer permitted to authorise absence for holiday taken in term time. They are permitted to grant leave only in exceptional circumstances. Holidays which are taken are unauthorised and if they are taken, parents are in breach of their legal duty to ensure that their child attends school full time and may be subject to a Fixed Penalty Notice.

The Parish Council have asked me to remind you that there are chevrons outside school to prevent you from parking directly outside the gate. They are in the process of arranging for the yellow lines to be re-painted, so please refrain from parking on the yellow lines at all times.



Explore Learning Maths Workshop
