**Preparation for absence and possible closure**

The Government directive is for schools to close after school on Friday except for key worker children and vulnerable children. During the period that the school is closed we will continue to provide a high quality education for all our children.

The staff are currently working on Home Learning packs that will be available for all children. The packs will be available on Friday afternoon and can be emailed out or given as a paper copy at the end of the school day.

Please will you indicate to staff using your child's home school record or via an email to [admin3214@welearn365.com](mailto:admin3214@welearn365.com) whether you would prefer your Home Learning pack via email or a paper copy.

Home Learning packs for Year 1 to 6 will contain:

- Common Exception words and a blank copy of the spelling sheet so that they can be practised daily
- 2 topic related activities
- 1 reading comprehension with answers. Part of the homework will be to talk about the text and work through the answers with your children
- 2 grammar activities (with answers, so that you can mark the work together)
- 3 maths activities (with answers, so that you can mark the work together)

In addition please support your child with:

- Daily timetable practice or number bonds - apps such as SpuQ (we use this in school), DK, Times Table Quiz!
- My Maths Activities - Please contact school if you haven't got a login. There are activities on the site to support learning and teachers may also set specific tasks
- Daily exercise such as a run around the garden, a walk or Supermovers (BBC) every day

Reception children will be offered more practical activities and revision of phonics covered so far.

These tasks are based on learning that the children have already experienced in school. They are designed to allow them to retrieve and embed key skills and knowledge. We will not be teaching live lessons with new learning. However, we are expecting the work set to be completed.

Please also use any time that schools are closed for family time. Turn off mobile phones and spend time together. Read to each other, play board games and enjoy being creative.
