## Home Learning & Key worker Arrangement January 2021.

Dear Newbold and Tredington families,

Newbold and Tredington C of E Primary School and Day Nursery will be opening to children of Key Worker families and those who are vulnerable (children with an EHCP or Social Worker) from Wednesday 6th January 2021. The school will be open from 8:00am to 3:30pm. I am currently discussing after school provision with Premier Active.

If your children are part of the Key Worker or Vulnerable group please complete the earlier Microsoft form that was emailed out earlier today ASAP.

Once you have completed the form I will be in touch to confirm the days and times required.

- Children should wear uniform as normal
- Children who are in school will have lunch from Educaterers as normal (or will bring their packed lunch)
- Children will remain in their class bubbles and staff will be available to support the remote learning that will be delivered to the whole class.

### For children who are working from home:

Daily Zoom Registration with class teachers in small groups. Teachers will notify children of the time of their daily meeting and we have timetabled the meetings so siblings will have different allocated times.

Your child's class teacher will go over the work being set for the day and the expectations around completing the home learning and submission of any items via Seesaw.

The expectation is that all children will join these morning meetings every day. Parents must supervise their children on Zoom during these sessions.

Children must be in an appropriate setting and wearing appropriate clothing to join Zoom.

We suggest a communal space such as the kitchen table or living room.

Parents will receive Zoom invites for the registration sessions the day before by 3:30pm via Seesaw.

### Seesaw

- Work will be set on Seesaw by your child's class teacher daily.
- New exercise books for topic (purple) and maths (blue) and their pencil cases will be delivered to your home address in the next couple of days so that children can work in their school books. Please ensure that this book is treated with care whilst at home, as it will return to school at the end of lockdown.
- Please continue to take photographs of completed work and submit it to Seesaw so that the teachers can mark it and provide next steps for your child.

### Communication with staff

Please continue to use the admin emails to contact staff. In due course we will have direct class emails so you can link to class teachers. Parents can also communicate with staff with school work related issues through Seesaw.
