Comic Relief 2024

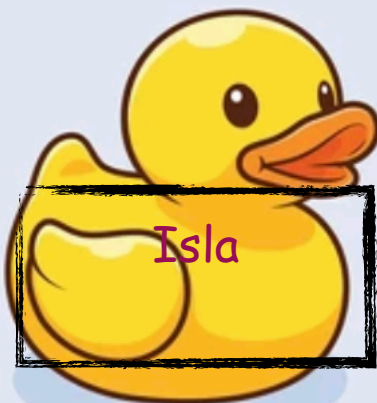
We will be having non-uniform day for Comic Relief with all donations going to the charity.

However, please note that as we have the Easter Service at St Gregory's church on Friday 15th March we will hold our non-uniform day on **Monday 11th March 2024**.

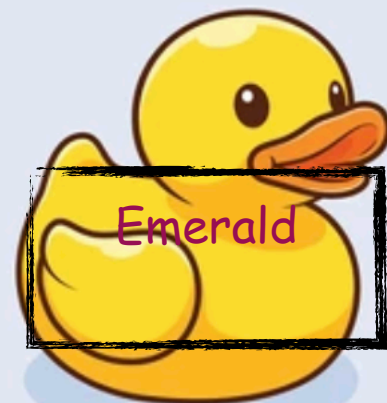


From January 2024 we will be hiring out the school hall so if you would like to host a birthday party or celebration please contact the school office for further details.
